

2018 MCC Invitational – Conditions of Competition

CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISION – The Invitational Champion will be the participant posting the lowest individual 54-hole score within this Division. Upon completion of play on Saturday, this Division will be divided into a Championship flight (approx. 20 competitors) and additional flights as determined by the Tournament Committee, for the final round.

Dr. Hamp Greene, III, Collegiate Cup – Collegiate Four-ball competition - low two-man team, 54-hole, total score

MID-AMATEUR CHAMPION - Participants 25-plus years old, competing in the Championship Division, will also compete for prizes and recognition as MCC Invitational Mid-Amateur Champion.

PRIZES – Gift certificates and crystal trophies will be awarded to the individuals recording the lowest totals in a given flight. All gift certificates must be redeemed on or before December 31, 2018.

METHOD FOR DECIDING TIES: Should a tie exist at the end of 54 holes for the Invitational championship or Mid-Amateur Championship, a sudden death playoff will commence immediately following play starting on #18 tee and will continue on hole 18 until a winner is determined. Ties for the Files Crenshaw Medalist Trophy, and for each flight will be decided by the method recommended by the USGA, Appendix I, “How to Decide Ties,” (Back 9, 6, 3) in the Rules of Golf.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: The Tournament Committee will make all decisions regarding any alteration to the format in order to complete play due to inclement weather. Should inclement weather force cancellation of one or more rounds, the Invitational will be shortened and the Invitational Champion, Mid-Amateur Champion, all flight winners and the medalist will be determined based upon holes completed as determined by the Tournament Committee. Signal to Suspend Play: Several Short Siren Blasts. Signal to Resume Play: One Long Siren Blast

The 2018 USGA Rules of Golf will govern play for the Invitational, except as may be determined by the Tournament Committee. In addition, please refer to the Local Rule Sheet for additional rules and information.
